PRN (As Needed) Report

The PRN Report provides detailed insights into "As Needed" medication or treatment, ensuring proper documentation and tracking of medications administered to residents. This report is a valuable tool for clinical staff to review PRN usage, monitor trends, and maintain compliance with care standards.

Report Highlights:

1. Fields Included:

- **Resident Name:** Identifies the resident receiving the PRN medication or treatment.
- **Medication Name:** Specifies the name of the medication administered.
- **Instruction:** Outlines the instructions for administering the medication.
- **Route:** Indicates how the medication was administered (e.g., oral, topical, IV).
- **Amount Given:** Documents the dosage provided.
- **Reason Given:** Captures the reason for administering the PRN medication (e.g., pain, anxiety, etc.).
- **Give Notes:** Allows staff to include any additional relevant notes about the administration.

PRN Orders Report

The PRN Orders Report enables a comprehensive review of PRN (as-needed) medication and treatment orders, empowering providers to maintain accuracy and ensure proper medication management practices. The report includes essential details for each PRN order.

Report Highlights:

- **Instruction:** Detailed administration instructions.
- **Route:** The prescribed method of administration (e.g., oral, topical).
- **Physician Name:** The prescribing physician for accountability and follow-up.

Add PRN Orders to Alternative Admin Window

- Enhanced the Alternative Admin window to include PRN orders, providing a more comprehensive view of a resident's medication profile.
 - PRN orders are now visible in the 'View Medications' window and display "PRN" in the Effective Time column.
 - Filtered PRN orders with an Alternative Admin status to show status badges across various screens.



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- These orders appear in the Alternative Admin section of every MAR Pass but are excluded from Scheduled or Overdue sections unless administered.
- PRN orders with Alternative Admin status are excluded from the 'PRNs for All Residents' window and display a watermark on MAR/TAR Pass.

Manage Orders > Handle Unknown Form When NDC Does Not Exist

- Introduced functionality to allow editing of medication orders without an NDC:
 - Users can now select a form from a dropdown menu, defaulting to "-select-" if no form exists.
 - The selected form persists through refill and renew scenarios, ensuring consistent management.
 - Removed additional labels for orders with a "-select-" form in the Medication Info Bundle.

Add Supply Order Control to Manage Order Screens

- Implemented a "Supply" checkbox on the Manage Order screen to manage Supply Orders:
 - When the "Supply" checkbox is selected, the order is flagged as a Supply Order.
 - Unchecking the checkbox reverts the order to its original type, such as MAR or TAR.
 - Verified that Supply Orders are excluded from MAR/TAR passes during the effective Supply period.

Update Legend on Offline MAR Form

- Updated the legend on the Offline Medication Administration Record (MAR) Form:
 - Changed the label from 'S - Scheduled' to 'X - Not Scheduled.'
 - Applied this update to both Group and Individual versions of the MAR report when viewed offline.
 - Improved clarity for medical providers interpreting MAR data.

Display Refill Date on Manage Orders, Medication Profile

- Enhanced the display of medication details on the Medication Profile and Manage Order screens:
 - The refill date is now displayed under the Start Date.
 - Invalid End Dates (e.g., January 1, 9999) are excluded for better usability.
 - Verified functionality to ensure the correct display of refill dates.

Issue Resolutions

Manage Orders Does Not Save Edits

- Resolved an issue where medication order edits were not being saved for certain residents.
- Successful test results confirm that edits now save correctly in all scenarios.

Hotlist > Hotlist Shows Loading Icon After Saving an Action

- Fixed an issue where the hotlist displayed an infinite loading icon after saving an action.
- The action is saved correctly, and the hotlist now updates without requiring a manual refresh.

Follow-Up Can Be Created Without a Scheduled Due Date

- Resolved an issue where follow-ups could be saved without a scheduled due date, despite fields being highlighted in red.
- The 'Add Note' button is now disabled until all required fields are completed.

Receive Orders > Medications Disappear if End Date is Before Start Date

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- Addressed an issue where medications would disappear if the end date was set earlier than the start date.
- The system now prevents saving incorrect date combinations, ensuring proper order visibility.

Dashboard > Expiring Orders Widget

- Fixed an issue where the Expiring Orders widget did not update the list of orders based on the selected "Expires In" timeframe.
- The widget now dynamically refreshes to show orders expiring within the selected timeframe.

Hotlist > Overdue Medications Show Empty Modal After Logging Bio Test

- Resolved an issue where the overdue medication modal displayed blank after completing a bio test.
- The modal now correctly displays order details after logging the bio test.

EMAR Navigation Menu Not Scrollable on Small Screens

- Addressed a navigation issue where the EMAR menu was not scrollable on smaller screens, rendering certain links inaccessible.
- Verified resolution on various devices, including iPad and MacBook Air.

MAR > Changing a Discharge Date Removes Previous Administrations from Preview

- Fixed an issue where changing a resident's discharge date incorrectly marked today's medications as discontinued instead of given.
- Medications now display as given today and discontinued from tomorrow, ensuring accurate previews.

Receive > Tick/Validation

- Resolved an issue where ticked boxes in the "Receive" section were deselected when switching between orders.
- Ticked boxes now remain selected during the order receiving process, ensuring user selections are preserved.

Incorrect Alert Message When Attempting to Pop a Med with Amount of Zero

- Fixed an issue where an error message ("Cannot read properties of undefined (reading 'current')") appeared when attempting to administer medications with a zero give amount.
- The alert now correctly informs users to manually administer medications with a zero give amount.

Physician Name Added to "Other" Field When Selected from Menu

- Resolved an issue where selecting a physician from the menu incorrectly populated the "Other" field.
- The "Other" field is now cleared when a physician is selected.

Hotlist > Incorrect Date Format for Overdue Orders

- Fixed the date format for overdue orders in the MAR system.
- Dates now correctly display in the format "Day, Month Date, Year".

Delete Buttons Missing from the Manage Order/Edit Order Screens

- Addressed an issue where 'Delete' buttons were missing for schedules without administration history in the Manage Order and Receive Orders screens.
- Schedules without history now show the 'Delete' button, while those with history display the 'End Schedule' button.

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IsBodyMapRequired Control Showing Incorrectly

- Removed the IsBodyMapRequired checkbox from the Manage Order screen in MAR Pass and Medication Profile sections.
- The BodyMapRequired filter has also been removed from the Medication Profile section in Orders.

Medication Disappears If End Date Added Is Before Start Date

- Fixed an issue where medications would disappear if the end date was set before the start date.
- The system now prevents saving invalid date combinations, ensuring proper visibility in profiles.

Self-Admin > New Orders Not Set as Self-Admin

- Resolved an issue where new orders were not defaulting to self-admin for residents marked as self-admin.
- Orders now appear in the Alternative Administration MAR pass by default, though further adjustments are planned for pharmacy-interfaced medications.

Reports > MAR Report Not Displaying Administration

- Fixed discrepancies in MAR report data caused by overlapping dates for orders of the same medication.
- A data fix was applied to ensure consistent and accurate report generation.

Start Orders from Current Date/Time Setting > Incorrect Label and Start Time

- Resolved an issue where the 'Start Date & Time' field was automatically adjusted and a 'Note' label appeared incorrectly.
- The setting now ensures proper behavior based on the 'Send to Receive Orders' checkbox and its status.

MAR > Some Residents Allow for Administered Meds Without Bio Tests

- Resolved a finding where some residents were able to have medications administered without completing required bio tests.
- The UI now consistently prompts for completion of bio tests before administering meds, ensuring adherence to expected behavior.
- The fix has been verified and successfully implemented.

MAR > Editing a Bio Test Result Doesn't Reflect in Clinical

- Fixed a finding where edits to bio test results in eMAR were not reflected in the Clinical system.
- Edits to bio test results now appear correctly in the Clinical system, ensuring data consistency.

Available PRNs for All Residents > Inconsistent Time Display in Bio Test Field

- Resolved a finding where the bio test time field occasionally displayed incorrect times, particularly for superuser admin accounts.
- A fix was implemented to ensure the time field consistently displays the current time when completing a bio test.
- The issue has been tested and resolved, with the fix verified and deployed successfully.



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Clinical

Clinical > Reports: Sort Cards Alphabetically

- Report cards in the clinical reports section are now sorted alphabetically by header from left to right, then downwards.
 - New cards added to the detail page are automatically sorted alphabetically.
 - Users can sort by category and search, with search results also sorted alphabetically.

Medical > History > TB Screen > Result Date and Result Not Required

- Fixed an issue where Result Date and Result fields were incorrectly required for saving a new TB Screen.
 - Users can now save a TB Screen without entering these fields, as expected.
 - The issue has been resolved and tested successfully.

Service Alert for No Admit Date

- Introduced a new alert system for services lacking an admit date for residents.
 - An alert icon is added to the services tab, indicating the missing admit date.
 - Clicking the alert opens a modal with a message "No admit date", which can be closed by clicking outside.
 - Ensures users can identify unscheduled services due to missing admit dates.

Clinical > Resident > Medical > Care Team: Add "Other" to Role Dropdowns

- Added an "Other" option to both Primary and Secondary Role dropdowns in the Care Team section.
 - Selecting "Other" enables an open text field for custom role entries, which are saved to the resident record.
 - Allows modifications or deletions of roles while maintaining historical data for disabled medical professionals.

Clinical > Care Team > Add Medical Professionals from Resident Chart

- Enabled clinical managers to add medical professionals directly from the resident chart.
 - A toggle in the Care Team modal allows users to either search from the Community Lists or add new professionals.
 - Added professionals are saved to the Community Lists with "Enabled" status by default.

Evaluation > Service Plan > Suggested Service Discontinue to New

- Improved handling of resident care services during evaluations:
 - When a service is re-suggested after being discontinued, the start date updates to the new suggestion date.
 - A new care service is created for residents instead of modifying discontinued ones.
 - Ensures proper creation of services when copying forward or adding evaluations for ended services.

Pharmacy Errors > Improve Details Messaging

- Enhanced the Pharmacy Errors dashboard to improve the readability of error details:
 - Replaced the raw JSON format with a user-friendly modal that displays pharmacy vs. resident data.
 - Highlighted mismatches in critical fields like Date of Birth (DOB) and Social Security Number (SSN).
 - Introduced functionality to expand or collapse the full HL7 message for more or less detail.



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- Added a "View Message" button to display the full JSON message and an "Ok" button to close the modal.
- Ensures clearer and more actionable insights for users addressing pharmacy errors.

Clinical > Dashboard > Pharmacy Errors: Accept Mismatch Button

- Added an "Accept Mismatch" button for handling specific pharmacy errors.
 - Users can select records and process messages with SSN or DOB mismatches, removing the errors from the dashboard.
 - The button activates when one or more error records are selected.
 - Not applicable for "Multiple Resident Type" errors.

Clinical > Residents > Print > Facesheet: Identifying Marks

- Introduced a new "Identifying Marks" field in the Demographics section of the Facesheet.
 - Displays "None" if no data is entered, or the resident's identifying marks from the Profile tab.

Clinical > Resident > Profile > Demographic > Appearance: Identifying Marks

- Added an "Identifying Marks" field to the resident's appearance section.
 - Open text field with a 200-character limit, defaulting to "None" if empty.
 - Data entered here populates the Facesheet and complies with Pennsylvania state requirements.

Clinical > Reports > Resident Notes Report

- Implemented a Resident Notes Report for reviewing notes entered in the last 24 hours.
 - Includes filters for encounter date, resident name, note type, and employee.
 - Displays data in a table format with columns for encounter date/time, resident name, unit number, note type, details, and entered by.

Clinical > Config > Forms > Service Agreement: Update Character Limit

- Increased the character limit for Block One and Block Two fields in the Service Agreement form from 5,000 to 20,000 characters.
 - Fields expand as text is entered, with a scroll bar appearing after 16 lines.
 - Modifications are reflected in printed Service Agreements.

Clinical > Resident > Services: Single Service

- Added functionality to schedule a single service for a resident on a specific date.
 - Services not delivered by the specified date are marked as "Missed".
 - Services are only visible on the assigned date and do not appear in future schedules.

Clinical > Schedule > Services Alerts / Resident > Service Plan Alerts: Unify Alerts

- Unified service alerts across the Scheduled and Service Plan sections for consistency.
 - Updated alerts include:



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- Missing Unit Information: No unit assigned or missing move-in date.
- No Service Provider Assigned: No role assigned in the Service Catalog.
- Unit Unassigned: No unit assigned in Manage Units.
- Missing Scheduling Information: Missing frequency or time details.
- Add Future Move-In Date: Resident has a future move-in date.

Service Plan > Add New > Default to Current Date and Time

- Updated the Service Plan feature to improve user efficiency when adding new service plans:
 - The starting date and time fields now default to the current date and time.
 - Previously, these fields were blank, requiring manual input.
 - This update streamlines the creation of new service plans by reducing redundant steps.

Fixes

Evaluation Copy Forward > Service Name Not Updated

- Resolved a finding where the new service name did not display in evaluations copied forward from an existing evaluation with the old service name.
- The service name now updates correctly in new evaluations, ensuring consistency.

Future Move-In and Transfers Not Displaying Properly

- Fixed a finding where future move-ins and transfers did not display the correct move-in date/time or status in the Housing tab.
- Future transfers also incorrectly displayed the occupancy end date on discharge cards and the wrong placement in the History section.
- These scenarios have been resolved and tested successfully.

Config > Evaluations > Service Name Updates Not Reflected in Evaluations

- Addressed a finding where updates to a service name did not automatically update in associated evaluations.
- The updated service name now appears correctly in evaluations, except for existing resident evaluations where changes are not expected.

EMAR / Clinical > Dashboard > Pharmacy Errors

- Resolved a finding where medication orders were automatically rejected due to mismatched DOBs, causing delays.
- Implemented a flagging mechanism for mismatches to allow for manual review instead of automatic rejection.
- The process now ensures smoother medication order handling.

Clinical > Dashboard > Incomplete Admissions: Missing Unit on Discharged Resident

- Fixed a finding where discharged residents with future dates incorrectly appeared on the Incomplete Admissions Dashboard due to missing unit information.
- The issue has been tested and resolved, ensuring accurate dashboard data.

Service Status History Showing Inconsistencies Depending on How It's Ended

- Addressed a finding where inconsistencies occurred in Service Status History when ending services using the 'Stop' button.
- The 'Stop' button now only adds an end date to the current line without modifying previous lines.

Summary > Allergies Display

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- Fixed a finding where "No Known Allergies" was not displayed on the Summary tab when selected.
- The tab now correctly shows "There are no known allergies" if selected in the resident chart.

Clinical > Resident Record > Medical > Evaluations > Status Changes to 'Complete' Prematurely

- Resolved a finding where evaluations marked as 'Complete' ignored unanswered sub-questions like 'Additional Details.'
- The status now remains 'Draft' until all main and sub-questions are answered, ensuring completeness.

Question Types > Open Text > Not a Required Question to Save

- Resolved a finding where 'Open Text' questions in evaluations were not required to be completed before signing.
- The expected behavior, ensuring all questions (including 'Open Text') must be completed before signing, has been implemented.
- This issue has been tested and resolved, with all scenarios now passing as expected.

Question Types > Date > Not a Required Question to Save

- Fixed a finding where 'Date' type questions in evaluations could be left blank and still allow signing.
- The expected behavior now requires all questions, including 'Date' type, to be completed before signing.
- The issue has been tested and resolved, ensuring compliance with evaluation standards.

Plan Limit = 1 Should Show if a Service is Changed to Discontinued

- Resolved a finding where multiple care services with the same category and a plan limit of 1 resulted in the previously selected service being incorrectly marked as discontinued.
- The most recently selected service now remains active, and discontinued services are accurately reflected in the evaluation.

Face Sheet > Diet Is Not Printing

- Fixed a finding where Diet information was not printing on the Face Sheet
- The Diet field now prints correctly on the Face Sheet for residents with this information in their chart.

Community Settings > Users Appear Active After Inactivating

- Addressed a finding where inactive users were displayed as active in the community settings user list.
- Inactive users now appear correctly as inactive in all environments.

Correcting One Person Clears the List

- Resolved an issue where correcting one resident's details on the Incomplete Admissions Dashboard cleared the entire list.
- Now, only the status of the edited resident is updated, leaving other records unaffected.

Zero Minutes Not Persisting

- Fixed a finding where zero minutes in resident care services had to be manually re-entered for each save.
- Zero minutes now auto-populate and persist in the service modal upon creation, viewing, or editing.

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Residents with Removed Admit Dates Not Displaying

- Resolved a finding where residents with removed admit dates did not appear as "No Admit Date" on the Incomplete Admissions Dashboard.
 - Residents without an admit date now consistently display as "No Admit Date".
 - If both admit date and unit are removed, residents appear as "No admit date and missing unit".

SBAR Template Errors on Save When Resident Diagnosis Has No Code Value

- Fixed a finding where adding a note using the SBAR template caused errors if a resident's diagnosis lacked a code value.
- The problem has been resolved, allowing SBAR notes to save successfully regardless of diagnosis code presence.

Service Associated with Specific Time Configured Causes Errors and Will Not Save

- Resolved an issue where evaluations with services configured at specific times caused errors and prevented saving.
- The error no longer occurs, even when services are configured with specific times, and all subsequent questions now auto-save as expected.

Service Plan and Agreement Effective Date Not Respected

- Fixed a finding where service plans and agreements printed current services instead of those effective as of the selected date.
- Services with future start dates now correctly appear when printing based on the selected effective date.

Evaluation Scoring Levels Does Not Support Decimals

- Updated the Group Scoring modal in the Evaluation configuration to support decimal points.
- Fields for Starting and Ending Points now accept positive decimal numbers without overlap or negative values.
- The issue has been resolved, and decimals can now be entered successfully in scoring fields.

Service Agreement Printing Errors

- Resolved an issue where the Service Agreement incorrectly displayed the time in the Date column, leaving the Time column blank.
- The document now correctly displays the date under the Day column and the time under the Time column.

Services: Location Field Does Not Save "<" and ">" Symbols Correctly

- Fixed a finding where the "<" and ">" symbols did not save correctly in the Location field.
- The symbols now save as entered in both the Service Catalog and Residents sections.

Service Notes: Adding "<" or ">" Symbols Saves Incorrectly

- Resolved an issue where "<" and ">" symbols saved incorrectly in service notes.
- The symbols now save as entered, maintaining their intended form.

Clinical > Config > Service Catalog > Editing a Service Does Not Update Resident Service Plans

- Resolved a finding where editing service details like name, description, and category in the Service Catalog did not update associated resident care service records.
- Changes reflect correctly for relevant updates, while some setup changes are isolated to avoid impacting daily cares or resident services.



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Default Values in Configuration > Service Catalog Not Appearing in Service Plan Module

- Fixed a finding where default values set in the Service Catalog, such as equipment and schedule, were not appearing in the Service Plan module.
- Default options now correctly display and are editable when creating new services in the Service Plan module.

Showing "Unit Unassigned" on Active Services Despite Units Being Assigned

- Addressed a finding where alerts incorrectly showed "Unit Unassigned" for newly created services, even when units were assigned in Manage Units.
- Alerts now appear only when specific conditions, such as missing units or providers, are met.

Able to Edit Admit Date After the Discharge Date

- Fixed a finding where the system allowed an admit date to be set after the discharge date without error.
- The system now displays an error message, "Admit date cannot be after Discharge Date," preventing invalid date configurations.

Entering End Date/Time Does Not Update Badge to Discontinued/Declined

- Resolved a finding where manually entering an End Date/Time failed to update the service badge to 'Discontinued' or 'Declined.'
- The badge now updates correctly upon saving, even without clicking 'Stop' first.

Issue in Configuration > Evaluations > Print > Greater Than/Less Than Symbols - Format Uneven

- Fixed a formatting issue where greater than and less than symbols appeared uneven in the Evaluation Print feature.
- The symbols now display consistently and uniformly across all printed evaluations.

Incomplete Dashboard Showing Residents with Future Admit and Complete Admission Record

- Resolved a finding where residents with future admit times appeared on the Incomplete Admissions dashboard, despite having complete admission records.
- The expected behavior, ensuring residents with complete admission records do not appear on the dashboard, has been implemented and verified.

Clinical > Resident Chart > Medical > Evaluations > Unable to Sign Evaluation with Additional Details Fields

- Fixed a finding where users were unable to sign evaluations due to an issue with additional details fields in specific scenarios.
- The problem occurred when evaluations included two questions of the same type, with additional details toggled for only one answer.
- Users were incorrectly alerted for unanswered questions, even when all fields were completed.
- The issue has been resolved, and users can now sign evaluations without errors if all fields are answered.

Risk Management

Risk Management: Link Sentinel Event Configuration to Incident Form Sentinel Event Question

- Updated the Sentinel Event configuration to dynamically reflect changes in the title across incident forms and records.

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- Changes to the Sentinel Event configuration title now update the corresponding question in Risk Management > Incidents.
- The updated title is reflected in printed forms, such as the Resident Incident Template and Medication Incident Template.
- Modifications to the configuration are tested to ensure the question updates correctly in both incident records and printed forms.

Risk Management > Dashboard: Detail Page Updates

- Improved the usability of the Risk Management Dashboard detail page:
 - Moved the Fall Incidents card next to the Time of Day Trend card for better accessibility.
 - Enhanced the Top Residents with Incidents card by adding an arrow icon, indicating it's clickable.
 - Integrated the Fall Incidents dashboard into the Fall Incidents card without changing its functionality.

Risk Management: Link Sentinel Event Configuration to Incident Listing Page

- Updated the Adverse column on the Risk Management Incidents page to reflect changes to the Sentinel Event configuration title.
 - Changes to the Sentinel Event title are dynamically updated in multiple areas, including the Sentinel Event card, detail page, subtexts, and headers in the Risk Management module.
 - Modifications to the configuration title are verified to ensure the updates propagate correctly across the module.

Risk Management: Vital Signs Are Optional on Forms

- Made vital sign fields optional on the Incident/Accident Form and Medication Incident Form based on multiple client requests.
 - Users can now complete and sign these forms without mandatory vital sign input if the data is unavailable.
 - This update addresses usability issues where forms were previously left unsigned or filled with incorrect data due to required vital sign fields.

Fixes

Incident Reports Received as Triplicates

- Resolved a finding where communities received three duplicate emails for a single New Incident Notification.
- Testing confirmed that no duplicate notifications were generated, and the issue is now functioning as expected.

Incident Notifications > Date Incorrect

- Fixed a finding where incident notifications were sent in bulk with incorrect incident dates.
 - Notifications now display accurate dates and are sent at specific times, ensuring correct timing.

Incident Notification Link to Incident

- Addressed a finding where incident notification email links did not direct users to the incident after login.
 - Clicking the link previously led to a login screen, requiring users to manually navigate to the incident.

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- Links now correctly redirect users to the specified incident upon logging in, improving usability.
