Release Overview

This release delivers enhanced **medication intelligence and workflow efficiency within EMAR**, giving clinical teams greater visibility into drug classifications, controlled substance schedules, and medication usage patterns. Alongside these improvements, updates to Receive Orders workflows and audit tracking provide a more streamlined, transparent, and consistent medication management experience.

From automatic classification and state-aware controlled substance handling to a new Medication Classifications dashboard and simplified order validation workflows, these enhancements help teams make more informed decisions, improve regulatory alignment, and reduce friction in daily operations.

Highlights

Medication Classification & Controlled Drug Schedules – Automatically assign drug classifications and controlled substance schedules using GPI-based logic, with state-level support and enhanced visibility across key workflows.

Enhanced Drug Information Visibility – New classification and controlled substance schedule details surfaced directly within Medication Profile, MAR Pass, and Receive Orders for improved clinical context.

Medication Classifications Dashboard – A new dashboard widget provides flexible filtering and reporting on medication usage by classification, supporting trend analysis and regulatory review.

Receive Orders Workflow Improvements – Streamlined validation, filtering, and action workflows allow users to review, receive, or reject orders directly within modal experiences, reducing navigation and improving efficiency.

Expanded Audit Tracking for Bio Tests – Detailed audit visibility for bio test configurations and overrides, strengthening traceability and compliance.

Stability & Data Consistency Improvements – Improved pharmacy availability and synchronization between Clinical and EMAR to ensure accuracy.

Together, these enhancements improve visibility, strengthen compliance, and simplify medication management—helping teams deliver safer, more informed care.

EMAR – Medication Classification & Controlled Drug Schedule Enhancements

We're introducing enhanced medication intelligence within EMAR, bringing greater visibility into drug classifications and controlled substance schedules across key workflows.

Medication Classification (GPI-Based)

Medication orders now include a **drug classification** derived from the GPI and mapped through a standardized drug classification library.

- Classification is automatically assigned when:
 - Orders are received via pharmacy integration
 - Orders are created internally (Add to MAR/TAR)
- Backed by a maintainable classification table aligned to industry-standard groupings (e.g., Cardiovascular Agents, Antidepressants, Antibiotics)

State-Level Drug Schedule Support

Drug schedules now reflect **state-specific definitions** when applicable.

- Automatically determines community state from settings
- Uses state-level schedule when it differs from federal
- Falls back to federal schedule when no state override exists
- Applies consistently across:
 - Medication Profile
 - MAR Pass (including highlighting behavior)
 - Receive Orders
